“Who Is This?”

Matthew 21:1-11

I. Introduction

- Welcome to Holy Week - The most consequential week in the history of our planet!
- Two Questions
 - Who is this man?
 - What difference does it make to me?

II. The Confrontation

- The prophecies (Zech. 9:9; Gen. 49:10-11)
- The Messianic secret
- Jesus boldly assumes the role of Messiah

III. The Paradox

- Why a donkey and not a tank?
- Salvation not by force, but through sacrificial love
- The punishment that brought us peace (Isaiah 53)

IV. Crown Him or Crucify Him?

I am trying here to prevent anyone saying the really foolish thing that people often say about Him: I'm ready to accept Jesus as a great moral teacher, but I don't accept his claim to be God. (...) You can shut him up for a fool, you can spit at him and kill him as a demon or you can fall at his feet and call him Lord and God, but let us not come with any patronizing nonsense about his being a great human teacher. He has not left that open to us. He did not intend to.
